


Civil War Veterans buried in the Old Mount Calvary Cemetery, Burlington, VT

Francis Shiatte alias Francois Brault dit Chaillot

Born Brault dit Chaillot, Shiatte in Civil War, Chiot at Catholic Cathedral, Brau (Brault) dit Chaillot & Chaillotte at St Joseph's, Shyot in Ancestry, Shiot in Mass 1860 Census, Shyette in Burlington City Directories.



Enlisted: 28 Jul 1864 at age 18, credited to Morristown, VT

Mustered In: 28 Jul 1864 as a PVT in the 2nd VT Light Artillery Battery; transferred to the 1st Heavy Artillery company on 1 Mar 1865

Mustered Out: 28 Jul 1865

Born in Burlington on 27 May 1846

Baptized at the Cathedral on 14 Jun 1846

Death: 13 Aug 1912 in Burlington, VT; fractured his hip after falling from stairs. (Note: The Army record and the Burlington Free Press indicate the 14th)

1860 Census of Palmer, MA - His Father appears to have died already.

Francis Shiatte died yesterday morning at 2:10 o'clock at the home of his sister, Mrs. Julia Lavalley of 193 Elmwood avenue, after a long illness, and following the fracture of his hip about two months ago. A general breaking-down led recently to a slight shock.

He was born in this city May 27, 1846, his parents being Mr. and Mrs. Peter Shiatte. He enlisted at the age of 17 in the Second Battery, Vermont Light Artillery, July 28, 1864, for one year, was transferred to the First Company, Heavy Artillery, March 1, 1865, and was mustered out July 23, 1865.

For 30 years after the war he lived in Tilton, N. H., where he married Pauline Trombley, who died 15 years ago, and since that time he has made his home in this city. He was a member of the Tilton G. A. R. Post until it broke up through decline in membership. He was a painter by trade.

He is survived by two brothers, Peter Shiatte of this city and Andrew Shiatte of Tilton, and by three sisters, Mrs. Julia Lavalley and Mrs. Hattie Mitchell of this city and Mrs. Frank Mongeon of Anson, Maine.

The funeral will be held Friday morning at nine o'clock in St. Joseph's Church, with interment in Mount Calvary cemetery.
