Enlisted 5 May 1864 age 30 credited to St Albans, VT

Mustered In: 11 May 1864 as PVT Co. I 4th VT Vol Inf,
transferred to Co. F on 25 Feb 1865

Mustered Out: 13 Jul 1865

Died 14 May 1914 (sic)

Baptized 3 Jan 1836 at St Marie de Monnoir, Marieville,
PQ as Hypolite Alix, son of Pierre Alix and Marie Dore;
born the same day.

20 Sep 1869 marriage of Hypolite Alix son of Pierre Alix and Marie Dore, all born in Canada; and Sophie Dion, born NY, daughter of Pierre Dion and M. Gen. Laroque at St Josephs in Burlington.

1870 Census in Burlington: Paul age 34 Cabinet maker - Carrie age 23

1880 Census in Burlington: Allis, Paul, Carolina and Georgiana; ages 42, 33 and 15; cabinet maker

1884 St Joseph Census: Alix, Paul and Sophie Dion and Georgiana Dion (sic) age 17

1890 Veteran Schedule: Paul Alix at 262 North Winooski Ave, Burlington, VT

1900 Census at Burlington, VT: Paul Alex born Jan 1836; Caroline born 1847; imig 1855, Naturalized 1872

1910 Census at Burlington, VT: 260 North Winooski Ave
