**Enlisted:** 23 Aug 1862 at age 21 at Burlington, VT  
**Mustered In:** 10 Oct 1862, Pvt, Co. A, 13th VT INF  
**Mustered Out:** 21 Jul 1863  
The 13th regiment was a 9 month regiment. They fought off Pickets Charge at Gettysburg on 3 Jul 1863 and then mustered out 3 weeks later.

**ReEnlisted:** 14 Feb 1865  
**Mustered In:** 14 Feb 1865, Pvt, Co. B, 7th VT INF  
**Mustered Out:** 14 Feb 1866
