Civil War Veterans buried in the Old Mount Calvary Cemetery, Burlington, VT

John Scarbo alias Jean Baptiste Lescarbeau by John R. Fisher

John Scarbo is buried at the Old Mount Calvary cemetery in Burlington between Archibald and Pomeroy streets, which is owned by St Joseph parish. John enlisted as a private in the Civil War in Milton, VT on 1 Nov 1863 at age 21 and enlisted in the 3rd Vermont Light Artillery on 1 Jan 1864. He transferred on 27 Dec 1864 to the 1st Company 2nd battalion and finally mustered out on 24 Jul 1865. His total time in the Army was 1 year, 7 months and 21 days.

I have not been able to find his birth certificate or baptism in Vermont but there were many references to the fact in the various censuses. His siblings named Lucie, Margaret and William were baptized at the Cathedral in 1845, 1847 and 1848. The surname was recorded as Lescorbau and Corbier.

We next find the family at Joliet, IL in the 1850 census and he is 4th of eight children of Fabian Scarbaugh and Margaret. What were they doing there?


However, in 1860 we see Baptiste Scarbo, age 16, in Milton as a farm laborer for the Drevy family.

On 26 Dec 1865 we find the marriage at Ste Anne church in Milton, VT of John Scarbo and Sarah Jodois (actually Zoe Jodoin). No parents were listed.

We also find two marriages at St Joseph church in Burlington for the Lescarbeau family. The 1st was for John's oldest brother Fabian who wed Louise Mandeville on 26 Dec 1852. Both marriages list their parents as Fabien Lescarbeau and Marguerite Fournier.

John Lescarbeau and Zoe Jodoin began their family of 12 in 1869 in Burlington, VT. All of these baptisms were performed at St Joseph's.

We then find John's 2nd marriage at St Joseph in Burlington to Ermine Lavallee on 4 Oct 1899 who was twice widowed previously.

1899 - Scarbo, John died 22 Mar 1900
