Per his baptism record, Oliver Garrow was born in Swanton, VT on 23 Jul 1843 and was baptized in Bromont, Quebec on 16 Aug 1843. Parents were Joseph Garant and Merence Vilandre.

On his 9 Jan 1920 death record, he was born on 16 Jul 1844.

He died in 1920 but his gravestone says 1844 - 1919.

Civil War status

He enlisted on 7 May 1861 and mustered in as a Private on 20 Jun 1861 to the 2nd Regiment of VT Volunteers and was in Company G.

Oliver was wounded at Salem Heights, VA on 4 May 1863 and was taken prisoner the same day. He was paroled on 16 May 1863. He mustered out on 29 June 1864 for a total of

From the Vermont Brigade.

MR. EDITOR:—I send you a list of the wounded Vermonters who were left as prisoners after the battle. It is furnished by our Surgeon, Dr C. M. Chandler, who, with Surgeon Henry Janes has just returned from the enemy's country, bringing all our wounded. Our hospital nurses, Porter, Bixby, and Ricker, have been carried as prisoners to Richmond. I hope to visit to-morrow Potomac Creek Hospital, where these wounded now are, and send you further particulars.

Oliver Garrow, Co. G, right knee; L. M. Wilson, in head and left hip; David Hazleton, in left side, since died; James Ryne, knee joint, died May 12th.

3 years, 2 months and 14 days. The Battle of Salem Church, also known as the Battle of Banks' Ford, took place on May 3 and 4, 1863, in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, as part of the Chancellorsville Campaign of the American Civil War.

Note that on the 1890 Veteran Census he was mustered in on 16 Apr 1861, that may be an error. It also stated that he received a gun shot wound through the right lung. In the newspaper article he was wounded in the right knee.

The 2nd VT Infantry was part of the First Vermont Brigade that was made up of the VT 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th regiments. They fought valiantly in many big battles.

Oliver's parents (Joseph Garand and Emerence Vilandre) also had children in VT:

Marie Louise Garand born 27 Aug 1848 bap 8 Oct St Mary, St Albans, VT

David Garand bap 25 Jan 1851 at St Joseph, Burlington, VT

On the 1860 census Oliver Garrow was in Colchester, age 18, born Canada

On 30 January or April of 1865 he married Mary L. Thompson at St Joseph church in Burlington. See the baptisms on the last page for their children.

On the 1880 census Oliver was 35 years old, occupation was a tinsmith, and he lived at 137 Lafountain Street in Burlington with his wife Mary, age 33 and their son Edward age 12.

Mary died on 26 Sep 1882 at age 35 and 8 months in Burlington, VT.

Oliver then married Sophie Martin. See the baptisms on the last page for their children.

The St Joseph marriage record uses the surname Garaud and the civil record uses Garron.

On the 1900 census Oliver, born July 1844 and age 55 was wed 17 years, born Canada and immigrated 51 years ago in 1849 and was naturalized. He lived at 63 Lafountain Street in Burlington.

On the 1910 census Oliver was age 66, Sophia was 48 and their daughter Olive was 14. He was a plumber and he lived at 31 South Main Street, Waterbury, VT.

Oliver Garrow, Civil War Veteran, Died at the Age of 75 Years.

The remains of Oliver Garrow, who died at his home on South Main street, were taken to Burlington yesterday afternoon for burial in St. Joseph's cemetery. Mr. Garrow was a Civil war veteran of Co. G, 2d Vermont Volunteers, having enlisted in 1861 and was honorably discharged in 1864. He was 75 years of age and formerly a resident of Burlington. He was married twice, his first wife, Miss Mary L. Thompson of Burlington, by which marriage one son survives, Edwin D. Garrow of Burlington, and four grandchildren. The second wife, formerly Miss Sophia Martin of Ticonderoga, N. Y., survives with one daughter, Olive, of Waterbury. He also is survived by one brother and one sister.


Oliver and both wives and 2 children are buried in lot 330 at the Mount Calvary Cemetery which is owned by St Joseph Church in Burlington, VT.


