



14 Feb 1769 - Baptism of Jean Poissant, son of Michel Poissant salt merchant, and Marie Anne Alliot, presented for baptism by Sr Jean Guibertand Maddle Jeanne Mee of LaTremblade



Present were Sieur Daniel Tondut, Charron father and Meynardye Young also many other relatives and friends.




12 Feb 1775 - Baptism of Paul Douineau born the 11th day, legitimate son of Pierre Douineau, salt merchant, and Elizabeth Poissant, of Lamotte, parish of Marennes. The godparents were Paul Gautier, salt merchant of the village of Larseau and the said parish, the godmother Anne Poissant of Lamotte in the presence of Sieur Bonnin and Charron elder.



15 Mar 1776 - Baptism of Pierre Douineau born the 13th, son legitimate of Pierre Douineau, salt merchant, and Elizabeth Poissant of the village of Lanseau, parish of Marennes. The godparents were Pierre Douineau paternal grandfather and Marie Anne Poissant maternal aunt; in the presence of the father of the infant, of Elie Charron and Jean Jacques Laboisse.



29 Oct 1778 - Baptism of Marie Anne Douineau born the 27th daughter legitimate of Pierre Douineau, salt merchant, and of Elizabeth Poissant of the village of Larseau, parish of Marennes; presented for baptism by Pierre Valleteau, salt merchant, and Marie Anne Alliot spouse of Michel Poissant.



01 Nov 1780 - Baptism of Andre Gautier born 26 October legitimate son of Paul Gautier, salt merchant, and Marie Anne Poissant, of the village of Larseau, parish of Marennes. Present was Andre Mougut and Anne Menager dit Young of Marennes. Witnesses were Jacque Fantin and François Roche all of this parish.



01 Nov 1780 - Baptism of Anne Elizabeth Douineau born the 26 October daughter legitimate of Pierre Douineau, salt merchant, and Elizabeth Poissant of the village of Larceau, parish of Marennes. Presented by Jacques S?egn and by Anne Poissant of la Motte; witnesses were Jacques Fantin and Francois Rocher.
