

Pfc. Arthur Trudo's Body Due To Arrive From Holland Wed.



The body of Pfc. Arthur Trudo (above) who was killed in Holland in 1945, will arrive at the Union Station Wednesday at 4:52 p. m. He formerly resided at 185 North Willard st.

Pfc. Trudo was born in Burlington March 4, 1919, the son of Arthur J. and Myrtle (Pecue) Trudo. Surviving are his mother, Mrs. Myrtle Simpson; a daughter, Theresa Trudo of New Bedford, Mass.; two sisters, Mrs. C. L.
