

# Dollard Lesage Of Winooski Dies in Action

Parents Notified  
Sailor Son Killed  
In Pacific July 28

A gold star will hang in another Winooski home as a result of news received by Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Lesage of 15 West Spring st., Winooski, informing them that their son, Machinist's Mate Dollard A. Lesage, has been killed in action in the Pacific, on July 26.

The sailor was sent overseas last March, and the last word the parents had of their boy, was July 20, when they received news from him telling them he was O.K. and for them not to worry.

He received his boot training at Sampson, N. Y., and was transferred to Gulfport, Fla., and from there to San Francisco.

Lesage is a graduate of St. Louis Convent and was employed by the American Woolen company before his induction.

He is survived by his parents, and six brothers, Bernard, Robert, Lawrence, Guy, John and Leo, and six sisters, Mrs. Rita Marte of Burlington, Loretta, Lillian, Mary-Ann, Rose-Marie and Cecile.
