

## Pfc. Lael Barber Killed in Action In Tank Destroyer Outfit in Germany

Pfc. Lael C. Barber, 20 (shown here), son of Mrs. Eva Barber, 115 Intervale ave., was killed in action in Germany Dec. 10, according to a telegram received by his mother from the war department.



Private Barber entered the army 28 months ago and has been overseas from Jan., 1944.

In a tank destroyer outfit, he served first in England and then in France and Germany with the advancing armies.

Besides his mother, he is survived by two brothers, George, Hartford, Conn.; and Vernon, Burlington; and four sisters, Mrs. Genevieve Charland, Richmond; Mrs. Constance Bleau, and Miss Lorraine Barber, and Miss Terese Barber of Burlington.
