

Pfc. Louis Nault Killed in Action

He Made Supreme Sacrifice in Italy

Mr. and Mrs. Joseph A. Nault of 36 Rose st. were notified Monday evening by the war department that their son,

Pfc. Louis Joseph Nault (shown here) was killed in action Feb. 20 in Italy. He had been overseas since March 18, 1943, and was stationed at the headquarters in the infantry of the fifth army.



Pfc. Nault volunteered for service Sept. 9, 1943, and received his training at Camp Wheeler, Ga. He was graduated from Cathedral high school in 1941 and attended St. Michael's college and school at Bloomfield, Conn.

Besides his parents, Private Nault is survived by one sister, Rita, his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ludger McCarthy, all of this city, and several aunts and uncles.
